Free Shoreline Naturalization Workshop and Onsite Visits

CAESAREA – Kawartha Conservation is once again offering a shoreline naturalization workshop to area residents.

The workshop will take place in Caesarea on Wednesday, July 18th from 7 pm to 9 pm, at the Caesarea Community Town Hall, located at 3554 Regional Road 57. Everyone is welcome to attend and admission is free.

The workshop will feature: The What, When and Why of Shoreline Naturalization; How to Reduce Erosion on Your Shoreline; and an overview of the new Cartwright Peace Park Shoreline Naturalization Project. Kawartha Conservation staff invite participants to bring their shoreline questions and concerns with them, and they will also be scheduling free one-on-one onsite consultations for area residents.

“Without investing a lot of time or money, residents can naturalize their shoreline and reap the rewards of less lawn maintenance, less shoreline erosion, better water quality, fewer Canada geese, and more,” says Melissa Thompson, Kawartha Conservation stewardship coordinator. “We encourage participants to bring their photos, plans and permit questions so that we can either assist them on the spot, or schedule a visit to their property to provide onsite advice.”
